RoHS Compliance

Due to the directivity 2002/95/EG, dated January, 27th.2003, on the restrictions of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronical equipment (RoHS), the restrictions regarding the use of Lead, Cadmium, Crome, Mercury and brominated flame retardants will become valid from July 1st.2006 for new developed electrical and electronical equipment, introduced to the market.

According to our current knowledge and the information received from our suppliers, the products of OECA are RoHS compliant starting March 1st. 2006

All products of OECA are compliant to RoHS, simply some older products contain lead. We point at label, package or delivery note to it.
